



Food Safety Task Force

The Food Safety Task Force works with industry experts, scientists, researchers, state & national legislators, & regulatory agencies to develop the food safety policies of the domestic mushroom industry, identify educational and training needs of the industry, and develop programs and services to meet these needs for members.



Human Resources Task Force

The Human Resources Task Force creates best practices and toolboxes for human resources professionals at mushroom farms and associated businesses such as an audit toolbox from a grower's perspective, sample forms, and processes.
