## EXAMPLE #2

Job Title: <b>Mushroom Weigher</b>	Job Location: <b>Retail Line</b>	Analyst: <b>Joe Safety</b>	Date: <b>02/23/2019</b>
<i>Task Description:</i>  <b>Worker reaches for a tray of mushrooms from a pallet sitting right beside them and weighs each till on the tray for weight accuracy. Places tills after weight is accurate on in-feed conveyor to be wrapped by wrapping machine.</b>			
Hazard Type: <b>None</b>	Hazard Description: <b>None</b>		
Consequence: <b>None</b>	Hazard Control: <b>No hazard, no control.</b>

# Job Hazard Analysis (JHA) Form

## EXAMPLE #1

Job Title: <b>Metal Shop Worker</b>	Job Location: <b>Metal Shop</b>	Analyst: <b>Joe Safety</b>	Date: <b>02/23/2019</b>
<p>Task Description:</p> <p><b>Worker reaches into metal box to the right of the machine, grasps a 15-pound casting and carries it to grinding wheel. Worker grinds 20 to 30 castings per hour.</b></p>			
Hazard Type: <b>Physical Injury</b>	Hazard Description: <p><b>Picking up a casting, the employee could drop it onto his foot. The casting's weight and height could seriously injure the worker's foot or toes.</b></p>		
Consequence: <b>Seriously injured foot</b>	Hazard Control: <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li><b>1. Remove castings from the box and place them on a table next to the grinder</b></li><li><b>2. Wear steel-toe shoes with arch protection.</b></li><li><b>3. Change protective gloves that allow a better grip.</b></li><li><b>4. Use a device to pick up castings.</b></li></ol>

## EXAMPLE #3

Job Title: <b>Sanitation Worker</b>	Job Location: <b>Growing</b>	Analyst: <b>Joe Safety</b>	Date: <b>02/23/2019</b>
<p>Task Description:</p> <p><b>Employee mixes verticide chemical solution to perform sanitation tasks.</b></p>			
Hazard Type: <b>Chemical Injury</b>	<p>Hazard Description:</p> <p><b>Skin - Severe skin irritant, prolonged or repeated contact may cause dermatitis.</b></p> <p><b>Eyes – Severe eye irritant. Liquid and mists may injure the eyes, causing corneal damage.</b></p> <p><b>Ingestion – May be irritating to the mouth, throat, and gastrointestinal system. Burning, pain, and diarrhea expected with large doses.</b></p>		
Consequence: <b>Severe irritation to the skin, eyes and ingestion system.</b>	<p>Hazard Control:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li><b>1. Use water proof protective gloves</b></li><li><b>2. Face shield when handling concentrate</b></li><li><b>3. Provide local exhaust to keep TVL ingredients below acceptable limits.</b></li></ol>		
<p>Rational or Comment:</p>
